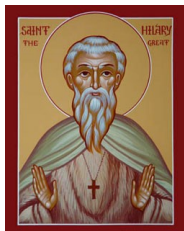

Saints of the Week



13th January

St. Hilary c. 315-367 Was elected bishop of Poitiers and distinguished himself by his stand against Arianism. Exiled by Emperor Constantius because of his anti-Arian efforts, he used the time to write. His major works include De

Trinitate, a study of the Trinity, and De

Synodis, a valuable historical record of the time; he also composed hymns.

15th January

St. Ita founded a monastery in Killeedy, Co. Limerick, which attracted a great variety of young people, some of whom became nuns. It became a place for prayer and work, penance and poverty. Boys seems to have attended her school also, whence her title "foster-mother of the saints of Ireland". She died in 570.
