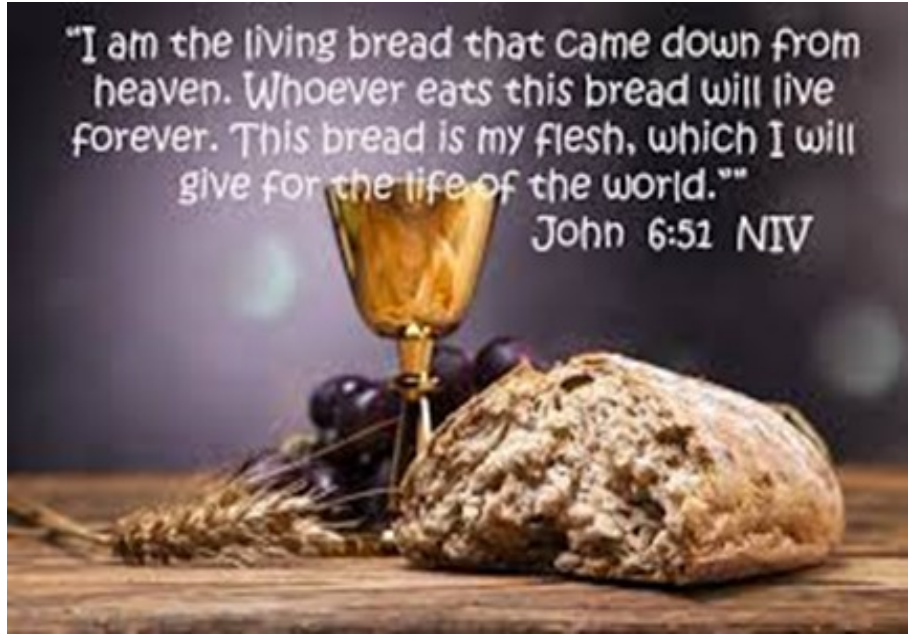
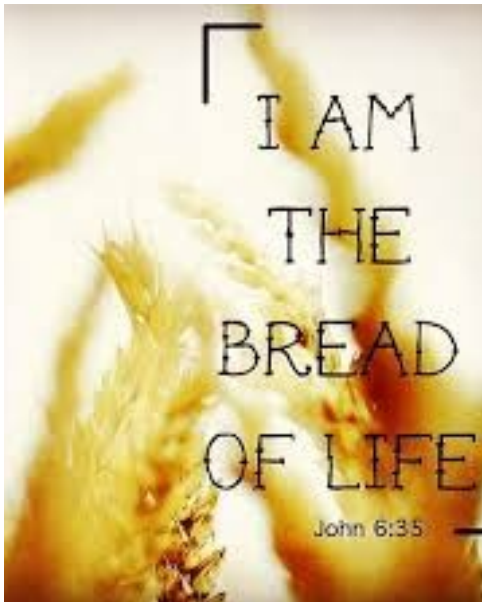

### Saints of the week

**Pope St. Sixtus II August 7th** Pope St. Sixtus and his four deacon companions were put to death in 258

**St. Cajetan, 1480–1547 August 7th** Founded the Theatines to renew sacramental life in the Church

**St. Dominic, 1170-1221 August 8th A**

Spaniard who founded the Order of Preachers to counteract the Albigensian heresy. The Dominican Order were first established in Athenry in 1241 and in Galway 1488 they have had an unbroken link with the city every since and through very difficult times.



**St. Thea August 12th** Dates to the 6th or 7th centuries. Local tradition remembers her great healing powers. Her convents were famous for hospitality and charity to the poor.

**St. Lelia August 12th** Had a church at Kileely, near

Thomand Bridge. She is said to have been baptised by St. Patrick.

**St. Fachtna August 13th Patron of the diocese of Ross** Is called the "son of the wright Mongach" by Dengus in his Martyrology. He was born in west Cork and is said to have been fostered by Ita. He was the founder of the monastery of Ross Carbery. He died around 600. the diocese covers west Cork.



**St. Hippolytus August 13th** He was a writer and teacher, who had been set up as a rival in opposition to Pope Callistus, was also exiled at the same time to

Sardinia. He was reconciled with Pontian and died, also from ill-treatment, at peace with the Church. Patron saint of horses and prison officers.

In our [First Reading](#) Elijah was frightened, exhausted and dispirited. He had come back to find the Israelites being unfaithful to the one true God. So he became miserable—in spite of his great triumph. He prayed to God to give immediate death to his worthless self. As despondent people will sometimes do, he went to sleep. He lay himself under a broom tree (a tall hedge that desert people used to shield themselves from the sun in the day and the wind at night).

God could have been harsh to Elijah as a result of this depressed prayer. But instead, a quiet touch from God's angel awakened the man. The angel whispered, "get up and eat." And, lo and behold, "there at his head was a hearth cake and a jug of water."

Elijah did eat and drink, but then settled right back to sleep again. The angel whispered tenderly, "Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you!" Elijah did and was strengthened.

In this reading, sometimes we are **Elijah** and sometimes we are the **hearth cake**. Think of times in your life when you wanted to cry, "enough" and you could have used some help from somewhere. Did help come? How?
