December 27th St John, (Apostle and Evangelist)

Brother of James, son of Zebedee, the disciple whom Jesus loved, is traditionally said to have died at Ephesus. He is considered to be the author of the fourth Gospel, the Book of Revelation and three Letters. The Letters especially teach the law of love; he is said in his old age to have preached only one message— **Love one another**.

Dec 31st St Sylvester Pope Tuesday He became bishop of Rome in 314 AD, soon after the Edict of Milan recognized Christianity. So Sylvester was free to build many churches in Rome. The Latern palace was given to him by Constantine and this became the cathedral Church for the diocese of Rome. He died in 335 and was buried in the Cemetery of Priscilla
