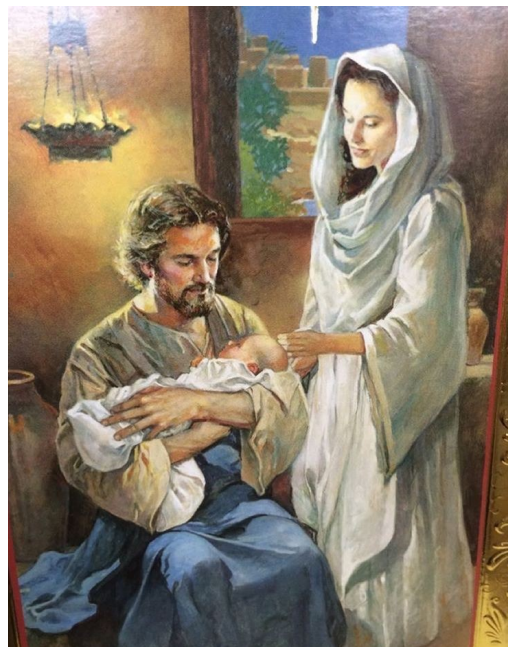

Saints of the Week



1st January The Solemnity of **Mary the Mother of God** The feast has a long history in the Christian Church and is celebrated in Eastern Church, Coptic Church and the Latin Church. It replaced the Roman feast of the Roman god Janus on the 1st of January and celebrates the motherhood of Mary 1914 the feast was on the 11th October and was celebrated as a feast for the whole church from 1931.

2nd January **St Basil the great** and **Saint Gregory**

Nazianzen Basil was born of a Christian family at Caesarea in Cappadocia in 330 AD. He was very good at his studies. He was appointed bishop of Caesarea. He fought the Arian heresy and wrote a number of Rules for Monastic



Life which are still used today. He is considered to be the Father of Eastern Monasticism.



5th January Blessed Charles of St Andrew. John Andrew Houben took vows as a Passionist in 1846 and came to Mount Argus Dublin in 1857 and it was there that he spent most of his priestly life. His ministry in confessional was renowned and the poor of Dublin found him a strong support. He died in the 5th in 1893.

6th January The Feast of the Epiphany.

7th January St. Raymond, Priest.

Born into a wealthy family in 1175, in Catalonia, Spain, Raymond became a brilliant lawyer prior to joining the Dominican Order. A very gifted priest, while he enjoyed solitude Raymond was active in the apostolate of reconciling heretics, Jews and Moors, as well as being a notable writer. He encouraged the great theologian, St. Thomas Aquinas, in his ministry of writing. Although reluctant to hold high office, Raymond eventually became Master General of the Dominican Order, Archbishop of Tarragona and confessor to the Pope. He died in 1275, aged one hundred
