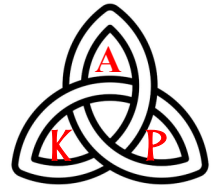

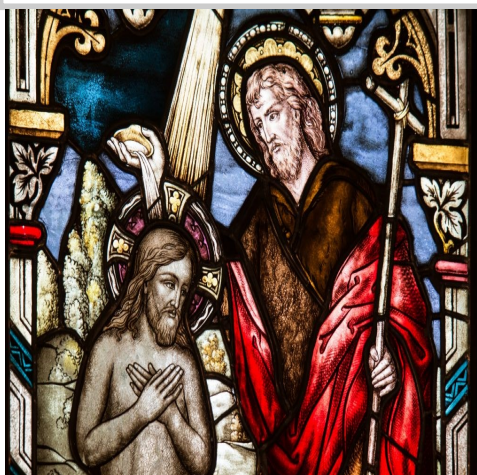

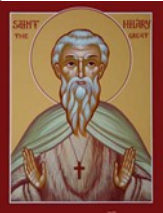

Saints of the Week

13th January St. Hilary c. 315-367

Was elected bishop of Poitiers and distinguished himself by his stand against Arianism. Exiled by Emperor Constantius because of his anti-Arian efforts, he used the time to write. His major works include De Trinitate, a study of the Trinity, and De Synodis, a valuable historical record of the time; he also composed hymns
