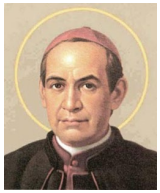

Saints of the week

24th October St. Anthony Mary Claret 1807-1870

Founded the Claretians in Spain for missionary work; Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba; returned as chaplain to the Queen of Spain, and built schools and museums, before being exiled with the

monarchy.

25th October Bl. Thaddeus McCarthy

Was born in 1455. His appointment as Bishop of Ross was opposed and Innocent VIII then appointed him bishop of Cork and Cloyne. He set out as a humble pilgrim to Rome where he was confirmed as bishop of Cork and Cloyne. On his return journey in 1492 he died at Ivrea in Italy.



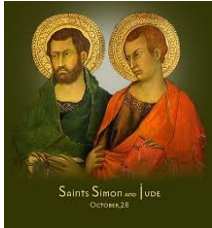
25th October English Martyrs

Both were Apostles. The name of Simon is placed eleventh in the list of Apostles.

Nothing is known of him except that he was born at Cana and was known as the Zealot. Jude, also known as Thaddaeus, was the apostle who, at the Last Supper, asked the Lord why he showed himself only to his disciples and not to the world (John 14:22). Jude's help is frequently invoked by students facing examinations. He is the patron of hopeless cases.

To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everyone else, Jesus told this parable: "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector.
