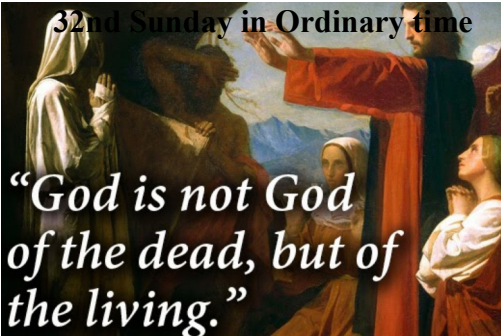

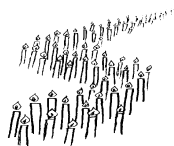

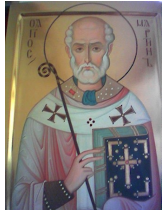

**9th The Dedication of the Basilica of John Lateran**

**10th St Leo the Great** Born in Tuscany Italy around 390. educated in Rome was sent to France to negotiate between the French and the Barbarians. The People and the clergy elected him Bishop of Rome. He worked hard on the doctrine of the Incarnation of Christ (God became man and is both God and Man). He fought against many heresies. He also worked to preserve the city of Rome, he prevented the Attila the Hun from



sacking the city, but failed to prevent the Vandals from sacking the city.

**11th St Martin of Tours.**

Born of Hungarian parents, 316 A.D. Martin from an early age was interested in Christianity. As a youth he cut his cloak in two and gave one piece to a naked beggar. Later in a dream Christ appeared to him with the cloak. Martin was baptised, and later, in turn, a soldier, a priest, a monk and finally bishop of Tours where he died in 395. He was totally devoted to his work and to the people of the diocese
