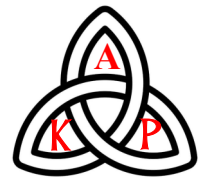

St. Agatha 5th Feb.

Died a martyr for the faith at Catania in Sicily in the 3rd Cent. Patron of Breast Cancer, bellfounders, against fire, Palermo, rape victims, and wet nurses

Sts. Paul Miki & Companions

6th Feb. Martyred at Nagasaki, Japan in 1597. The 6 Franciscans, 17 Franciscan Tertiaries, and 3 Jesuits died suspended on crosses. Canonized 1862



St. Mel Saturday 7th Feb. Patron of the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnoise Said to have been a Briton who came to Ireland with St. Patrick and with whom he worked until he was ordained in Ardagh. 488.

8th St. Jerome Emiliani,

converted in later life after a military career. He founded the Clerks Regular of Somascha for the care of orphans and the poor. Patron saint of orphans.

St Josephine Bakhita A native of Sudan, brought as a slave to Italy where she converted and became a Christian and entered the sisters of Charity.
