

St. Cyril of Jerusalem, 315-86 Bishop of Jerusalem. He excelled as a catechist and administrator, and suffered exile in his fight against Arianism.

St. Joseph



Joseph was engaged to Mary when he discovered she was pregnant. He knew he was not the child's father. An angel appeared to him and told him what to do. After Jesus was born, Joseph was warned in another dream that Herod planned to kill the child. He brought Jesus and Mary to Egypt, to protect them from harm. People still pray to St. Joseph for protection, remembering his fatherly care for Jesus. Joseph is

also the patron saint of the Church, of fathers and of a happy death.

21st March St. Enda Sunday Is considered to be one of the three great late vocations of Ireland. His sister Faenche, a nun, set his thoughts on a religious vacation. On Faenche's urging he went to Aran. Where he established a monastery which became one of the most important in

Ireland He died probably in 520 and is considered as one of the early models of ascetic monasticism in Ireland.

23rd March St Turibus of Mongrovejo Layman. Lawyer. Professor of law at Salamanca Spain. He was appointed to the post of Archbishop of Lima, Peru by King Philip II.

Founded the first seminary in the

Western

hemisphere. Fought for the rights of the natives against the Spanish masters and combated the abuses of the conquers.

Organized councils and synods for the reform of the church in the New World.

24th March St. Macartan Wed Patron Saint

of the Diocese of Clogher Is recognised as the first Bishop of Clogher. A disciple of St. Patrick, he founded his monastery at what had been a pagan sanctuary. The Diocese contains all of Monaghan, most of Fermanagh and part of Tyrone.
