

<u>Saints of the Week</u> St. Francis of Paola 2nd April

Was born in Calabria in the year 1416. He founded a congregation of hermits which was later called the Order of Minims and approved in 1506. He died at Tours in France in 1507.

4th St. Isidore Became bishop of Seville in the year 600 and ruled for

the next 36 years. His writings created

a veritable encyclopaedia of knowledge. He completed the Mozarabic liturgy.

5th St. Vincent Ferrer

A Spanish Dominican priest, preached missions in Europe, helped bring unity to the Church during the Great Schism, died 1419.

7th St. John Baptist de la Salle 1651—1719 Founded the Brothers of the Christian Schools.
