was born near Kilrush, County Clare. His vocation seems to have resulted from an experience of danger from the sea. His early studies were mainly made at the monastery of Kilnamanagh. His principal monastic foundation was on Scattery Island, Kilrush, in the Shannon

Estuary. He was anam chara to Ciaran of Clonmacnois and Brendan, and died in 544.

March 8th St. John of God

1495—1550 He is the patron saint of nurses, the sick, heart patients, printers and booksellers.



March 9th Francis of Rome. Married at a young age she had three children. Her husband died after 40 years of marriage and she joined a convent of Benedictine Nuns. She spent her wealth on the poor and needy of the city of Rome. She founded a home for abandoned children. She died in 1440

John Ogilvie March 10th He was raised in the New Faith of the Church of Scotland. He converted to Catholicism in Louvain Belgium. He joined the Jesuits and was ordained in 1610 he worked in France, he requested to work at home in Scotland. His wish was granted 1613. he worked in the underground church in Scotland. He was betrayed in 1614 and was arrested tried and put to death. Canonized by Pope Paul VI 1976
