

Saints of the Week


11thSt. Stanislaus Bishop and martyr born at Szczepanowski, in the Diocese of Cracow, 26th July, 1030; He was consecrated bishop in 1072, became a zealous reformer, a tireless preacher and a generous benefactor of the poor. He

Saint Marth Rose

fearlessly rebuked King Boleslav and was

murdered by him on the 10th May, 1097. Stanislaus was canonized in 1253 and is the patron of Poland. and the city and Diocese of Cracow.

13thMartin I pope and martyr. Born at Todi. In 649 he was elected Pope. He died in exile on April 13, the last pope to be venerated as a martyr.
