

Saints of the Week St. Matthias, 14th May


Like all the apostles, was chosen to become "a witness with us of Christ's resurrection". The story of his election as one of the apostles is given in the first reading. He seems to have spent a great deal of time working in Judea; then he travelled east to Cappadocia (now Turkey) where it is said that he was the vital instrument in bringing

may pagans to the faith. He is said to have been martyred at

Colchis on the Black Sea.

Saint Carthage 15th May

Came from Kerry. A year after ordination he went to Bangor he founded his own monastery at Rahan in 595. It grew rapidly. But opposition made him move southwards around 637. He, with hundreds of monks and



their patients from the leper colony, finally arrived at Lismore, where he made a foundation. He died in 638.

St. Brendan 16th May

Was a Kerryman who was born in 486. He studied at Clonard under Finnian. His name is connected with many places in Kerry such as Ardferret and Mount Brandon. He visited

Scotland and reached the Hebrides and possibly areas beyond. He founded a monastery in Clonfert in 568 and died there in 578.

St. John I 18th

Was involved in Arian controversies and imprisoned at Ravenna where he died
