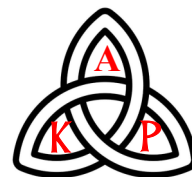

as a divine person.

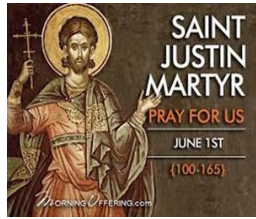

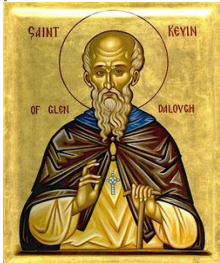

The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary
St. Justin 1st June
Was born in the Holy Land and settled in Rome. From paganism he became a Christian, wrote philosophical works, and



opened a school in Rome. He was martyred c. AD 165. Patron of philosophers.



St. Kevin 3rd June Was a native of Leinster and grew up in Kilmanagh, where he received his early religious formation. Wishing to be a hermit, he crossed the mountains to Glendalough and settled in Disert Caoimhghin at the foot of the Upper Lake. But disciples began to gather round him. Gradually the great monastic settlement grew, and spread through the glen after his death in 618.

Pentecost

After Jesus had ascended to heaven from Mt. Olivet, the apostles and disciples returned to the Holy City. They remained together in the Upper Room or Cenacle, the place where Jesus had appeared to them and which may well be called the first Christian church. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind coming, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them parted tongues as of fire, which settled upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in foreign tongues, even as the Holy Spirit

prompted them to speak.

Pentecost ranks among the great feasts of Christianity.

It commemorates not only the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Disciples, but also the fruits and effects of that event: the completion of the work of redemption, the fullness of grace for the Church and its children, and the gift of faith for all nations
