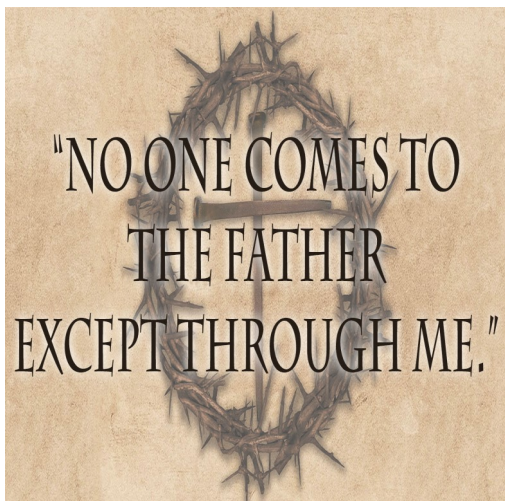

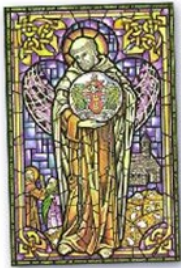

It is said that at one time there were 4,000 monks under his guidance. He also founded a monastery at Tiree in Scotland. After a long and difficult illness he died on the feast of Pentecost 602 or 605
