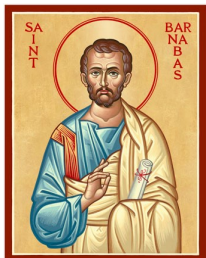

Saints of the Week

St. Barnabas 11th June Was born on the island of Cyprus. He was one of the first converts in Jerusalem and preached at Antioch. He became a companion of St. Paul and went with him on his first missionary journey, and he took part in the Council of Jerusalem. He returned to his native land to preach the gospel and

there he died.

St Anthony of Padua

Died in Padua in 1231 at the age of 36. Born in Portugal he had joined the Franciscans and preached against heresy throughout France and Italy.



St. Davnet 14th June Lived and died at Tydavnet at Sliabh Beagh, Co. Monaghan. A bachall (staff) said to have been hers has been preserved and in the past it was used as a test of truth.
