

Saints of the Week

St. Oliver Plunkett bishop and martyr 1625-81 July 1st

He was ordained a priest in 1654, in 1669 he was appointed archbishop of Armagh. Oliver was one of only two Catholic bishops in Ireland at that time. He was accused of high

treason in 1678 and hanged in 1681. He

was canonize in 1976.

St. Thomas July 3rd Is said to have preached the gospel in India where he was martyred. The faith that led him to know Christ in his wounds also sent him to the farthest places to preach. Patron of Architects.

St Anthony Maria Zaccaria, 1502-1539 July 5th


Was first a medical doctor before becoming a priest in
