

celebrates the mystery of faith and unity on and of the Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.






Saints of the Week

.St. Kevin 3rd June Was a native of Leinster and grew up in Kilnamanagh, where he received his early religious formation. Wishing to be a hermit, he crossed the mountains to Glendalough and settled in Disert Caoimhghin at the foot of the

Upper Lake. But disciples began to gather round him. Gradually the great

monastic settlement grew, and spread through the glen after his death in 618.



Uganda, Africa, Charles Lwanga and twenty-one

companions, several of whom were young boys serving as pages in the King's palace, were put to death because they refused the King's immoral advances. This happened



from 1885 to 1887, but still today they remain examples of bravery and steadfast loyalty to the teachings of Jesus. Made Saints by Pope Paul VI.

St. Boniface, 673-754 5th June Was born at Crediton in Devonshire and educated in monastery schools in England. He went as missionary to Germany. He founded monasteries in Bavaria, that of Fulda in 735.

St. Jarlath Patron of Tuam 6th

June St. Jarlath is said to have been a disciple of St. Enda, and was taught also by St. Benignus. He became abbotbishop of the monastery he founded at Tuam in the 6th century. He is the patron saint of the archdiocese of Tuam.

6th Norbert The founder of the Norbertines

7th St Colman Patron of diocese Dromore Founded the

monastery in Dromore



St. Colum Cille 9th June Was born in Gartan, Co. Donecal in 521. He studied under St. Finnian of Moyville and St . Finnian of Clonard. He founded monasteries in Derry, Durrow, Iona and possibly Kells. He left Ireland either for penance or to be a pilgrim for Christ, but Iona became his principal foundation. From it missionaries undertook the conversion of Northumbria. Colmmcille spent thirty-four years

as an 'island soldier'. He died on the 9th June 597. Patron Saint of the Diocese of Derry and Raphoe
