

Saints of the week

St. Robert Bellarmine 1542-1621 17th September

Jesuit, Cardinal Bishop of Capua, involved in theological controversies of the time. Patron of catechists.

The Korean Martyrs 20th Sept.The faith in Korea started and de-

veloped under lay leadership, until French missionaries arrived in secret in 1836. Three years later, began a long and terrible



persecution, during which over one hundred laypeople and Andrew Kim, the first Korean priest, died for the faith. They are known as the Korean mar-

tyrs.




St. Matthew 21st Sept.

The tax collector, may also be identified with Levi, son of Alphaeus in Mk. 2:13. He is said to have been a missionary in Persia and Ethiopia Patron of accountants, bookkeepers, tax-collectors, customs officers and security guards. At present we are using Matthew's Gospel in our Sunday Liturgy.

Padro Pio 23rd Sept.

Born in southern Italy in 1887 entered the Capuchin Order in 1903 and was ordained in 1910 after the WWI he received the Stigmata the word spread and pilgrims came to see the monk he founded a Hospital for the suffering 1947 and formed prayer groups in 1956, these still have wide appeal with over 400,000 members. He died in 1968 and was

beatified in 1999 and Canonized in 2002.



St Eunan 23rd Sept. Born in Donegal and was abbot of Iona. He patron of the Diocese of Raphoe the diocese covers most of Donegal.
