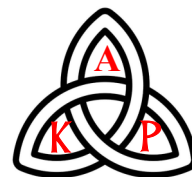

Saints of the week

1st October Theresa of Lisieux Marie Françoise Therese Martin was born at Alençon on the 2nd January, 1873 and died at the Carmel in Lisieux on the 30th September

1897. She was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II in 1997. Patron of missions, florists, aviators and France.

2nd October Guardian Angels Catholic tradition has recognised that not only individual people have guardian angels but also homes, cities and states.



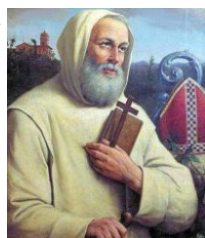
4th October St. Francis of Assisi 1181-1226,

Abandoned all things for the love of Christ, founded the Friars Minor, and with St. Clare the Poor Clares. For the last two years of his life he suffered the stigmata. The patron saint of ecologists.



5th October St Faustina Born the third of ten children in Poland. She worked as a domestic servant until she joined the sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. During her 13 years in the convent she fulfilled many different roles in the houses that she served. She had deep devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, to reconciliation and to Our Lady. She had a number of visions and mystical experiences and wrote of these experiences in a journal. She was asked to promote the mercy of God to each sinner. She died in 1938. when Karol Wojtyla was made Archbishop of Cracow he under took her cause. Beatified April 1993 Canonized April 2000

6th October St Bruno Educated in Paris and Rheims He was a teacher and principal of the University of Rheims he refused the election of Bishop. He left teaching and founded the Carthusians.
