Saints of the week


St. Finbarr 25th Sept. Parton of the diocese

Came to Loch Irce (Gougane Barra) and probably lived there as a hermit. When disciples gathered round him he moved to Cork at the mouth of the Lee where he founded a monastery that became a

famous centre of learning. The Diocese covers all of

cork city and areas around Bantry, Bandon and

St. Vincent de Paul, priest 1580-1660 Monday 27th Sept. Founded the Congregation of the Mission (the Vincentians) and the Daughters of Charity (1633), the first sisters to work outside their convents in active service.




St. Wenceslaus, 28th Sept. 905—925, Prince of Bohemia, killed by his brother. Patron of brewers.

shed their blood out of love for Christ in the city


