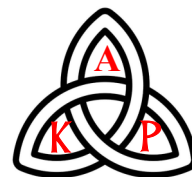

clothe the naked.



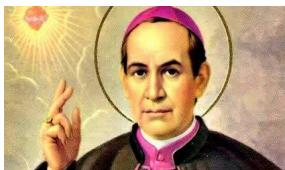


## Saints of the week

**23<sup>rd</sup> October John of Capistrano 1386-1456**

Studied civil and canon law and joined the Franciscan Order. In a battle at Belgrade he contracted fever and died there. Patron saint of jurists and military chaplains.

**24<sup>th</sup> October St. Anthony Mary Claret 1807-1870**



Founded the Claretians in Spain for missionary work; Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba; returned as chaplain to the Queen of Spain, and built schools and museums, before being exiled with the monarchy.



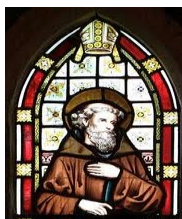
**25<sup>th</sup> October Bl. Thaddeus McCarthy**

Was born in 1455. His appointment as Bishop of Ross was opposed and Innocent VIII then appointed him bishop of Cork and Cloyne. He set out as a humble pilgrim to Rome where he was confirmed as bishop of Cork and Cloyne.

On his return journey in 1492 he died at Ivrea in Italy.

**25<sup>th</sup> October English Martyrs**

**27<sup>th</sup> October St Otteran** is variously described as a son or a companion or a predecessor of St Columba on the island of Iona, where there is a graveyard in his honour, the "Reilig Odhráin". He is also the principal patron of the diocese of Waterford, having been chosen for that honour by the Vikings. .
