Dec 12th St. Finnian, Bishop, settled in Clonard, Co. Meath, around 520, where he established a famous school. His pupils, among whom were Canice, Columba and Brendan, were the initiators of a great

monastic expansion in Ireland.

Dec. 13th St. Lucy, Virgin and martyr was a wealthy Sicilian who refused marriage because of her desire to be consecrated to Christ alone, gave her wealth to the poor and was accused by



a suitor to the persecuting authority. Lucy was killed by a sword. She is invoked for eye trouble

Dec. 14th St. John of the Cross,

A Carmelite who suffered much in his work of spreading the reform of the Carmelites, he was a man of prayer, outstanding poet and spiritual writer. Declared Doctor of the Church

This year is the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first re-enactment of the Nativity Scene by St Francis in Greccio, Italy. To mark the anniversary, there will be a display of cribs in the Abbey, from 8<sup>th</sup> December to 8<sup>th</sup> January. The Franciscans have been working hard on the project for the past few months. Cribs have been constructed and even knitted. Nativity scenes have been brought in from Italy to recreate a miniature Bethlehem.

The Greccio Chapel in the Abbey will be open all day on Saturdays and Sundays for the month. Groups, such as school classes, can arrange a tour during the week by emailing <a href="mailto:youfragalway@gmail.com">youfragalway@gmail.com</a> for an appointment.

Bishop Michael Duignan will formally open the exhibition on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December after Mass at 7.00pm. Children can have their *Bambinelli* (Baby Jesus figures) blessed at the ceremony.
