

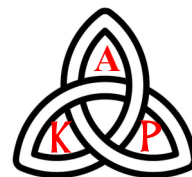

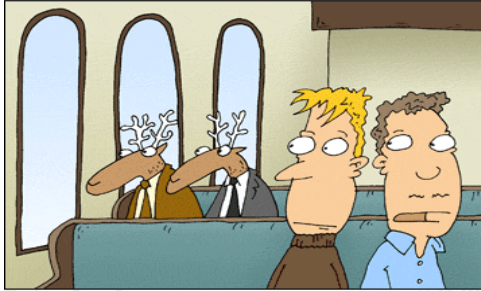

Saints of the week

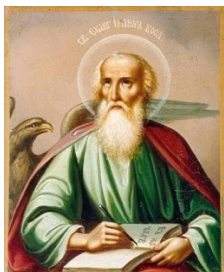
Dec. 20th St Fachanan,
Patron of Kilfenora
Although little is known with certainty about Fachanan, a strong tradition from early times links him with Kilfenora and records that he founded a church or monastery there in the sixth century. The Diocese was founded in 600 A.D. and was recognized by the

Synod of Kells, 1132 A.D.

During penal times the diocese was vacant a lot of the time. It survived as a Diocese until 1751. The diocese was seen as too small with only eight parishes to survive it was united with Kilmacduagh in 1751. The poverty of the two dioceses continued, as between the two there were only nineteen parishes, making it the smallest in Ireland. Pope Leo XIII united the three dioceses together in 1883, to form the dioceses of Galway, Kilmacduagh and Apostolic Administrator of Kilfenora.

Dec. 21st St Peter Canisius.

Peter (1521-'97) Jesuit priest, writer and educator. Born in Holland, his father was tutor to the sons of the duke of Lorraine. Peter intended to become a lawyer but joined the Jesuits. After his ordination he became a prominent preacher, attended two sessions of the Council of Trent and worked beside Ignatius of Loyola in Rome. He is generally reckoned to be the principal theologian and writer of his generation in Central Europe
