


Saints of the week

6th Dec.St Nicholas. Patron of Galway City, He was a 4th Cen. Bishop of Myra.
Little is known about his life but the legends of his great acts of kindness grew.
Throughout East and West hundreds of churches were dedicated to him. With the

sack of Myra by the Muslims the body was transferred to Bari, Italy, this brought his cult to the West. The fame of his cult reached Galway through the port. It became very popular and in the 14th Cen. The Collegiate Church was dedicated to him. The Parish Church of St Nicholas covered the four city parishes until St Joseph's was opened in 1882, and St

Patrick's on the other side of the Corrib. The new Cathedral was dedicated to him in the 1960's.

7th Dec St Ambrose Bishop and Doctor of the Church. He was governor of Milan and in 374 the laity insisted that he become Bishop, though he was still not
