#### Saints of the week

**15th Jan St Ita** founded a monastery in Killeedy, Co. Limerick, which attracted a great variety of young people, some of whom became nuns. It became a place for prayer and work, penance and poverty. Boys seems to have attended her school also, whence her title "foster-mother of the saints of Ireland". She died in 570.

.16<sup>th</sup> January St. Fursa was born in Ireland and became one of the great monastic missionaries abroad. He went first with his brothers Foillan and Ultan to live the monastic life in East Anglia. But as great numbers continued to visit him there he left his brother Foillan as abbot and sought refuge in France around 644. A patron gave him a hermitage at Lagny on the Marne. He died about 650 at Mezerolles while on a journey His body was buried in Péronne, which became a great centre of devotion to him.

17<sup>th</sup> January St Anthony of Egypt.He took seriously the Lord's challenge to give everything he had to the poor. He spent his life as a hermit. He founded the first Christian monastery, where people lived apart but came together to

worship. Died 356.

20th January St. Fabian


Was Pope for 14 years when martyred under The Roman Emperor Decius. Died 250
