Saints of the week

...St. Aengus, Tuesday 11th March Died 830, was a monk in Clonenagh, Co. Laois, who came to the monastery of Tallaght. He composed two Martyrologies, thus showing his devotion to both foreign and native saints. He returned to Clonenagh, where he became both abbot and

bishop.

St. Peter Damian 1007—72 AD

13th March

Born at Ravenna, lost both his parents in child-hood. Became a monk in 1035 when he joined the Camaldolese Benedictine Monastery. Peter became abbot in 1043. In 1057 he was appointed bishop of Ostia. He took a prominent part in the Gregorian Reform.
