

He received the faith form missionaries or from French Traders. He went to the Continent, where he was baptised and later ordained priest and bishop. He returned to his father's

territory, Ossory, and seems to have lived as a hermit. The diocese is made up of most of Co Kilkenny, part of Laois and one parish in Offaly.

7th Sts. Perpetua & Felicity Martyred in Carthage AD 203.March 8th.St. Senan. was born near Kilrush, County Clare. His vocation seems to have resulted from an experience of danger from the sea. His early studies were mainly made at the monastery of

Kilnamanagh. His principal monastic foundation was on Scattery Island, Kilrush, in the Shannon Estuary. He was anamchara to Ciaran of Clonmacnois and Brendan, and died in 544.


