



young and he support his family while studying. When ordained he worked in several parishes in Spain in 1928 he started Opius Dei after the |Civil War in Spain he moved to Rome . he worked the rest of his life in organizing the Society.



St. Cyril 370-444 27th

June Patriarch of Alexandria, fought against Nestorianism at the Council of Ephesus, 431, which proclaimed Mary, Mother of God.

St. Irenaeus 28th June Lived just after the time of the Apostles and knew those who had seen and talked with them. With this background and with his own zeal and learning, Irenaeus was an

invaluable help to the Church. He became Bishop of Lyons, the largest trading centre in Gaul.
