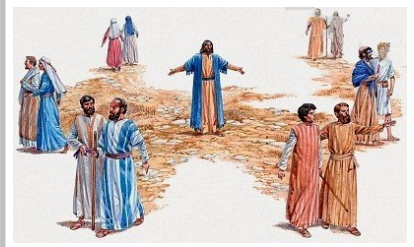

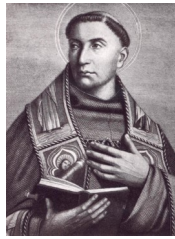

Saints of the Week



St. Camillus de Lellis 1550–1614 14th July He was rough-tempered and a gambler in his early life as a soldier. Was converted at the age of 25. Guided by St. Philip Neri he became a priest and worked for the sick with two companions. His servants of the Sick prospered and founded hospitals especially where others would not go. Patron of nurses, hospitals and the sick.



St. Bonaventure 1221–74 July 15th

Born in Tuscany, Minister - General of the Franciscans, Cardinal Archbishop of Albano, theologian of the Council of Lyons. Canonized in 1482, he was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1588.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel July 16th

The sacred scriptures speak of the beauty of Mount Carmel where the prophet Elijah defended the faith of the people of Israel in the living God. In the twelfth century a group of hermits settled there and afterwards set up the Carmelite Order to lead a contemplative life under the patronage of the Holy Mother of God. There are Carmelite priests and nuns in Loughrea. St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite priest in Kent, England, received in a vision the Brown Scapular from Our lady.



St Apollinaris. 20th July

Bishop, martyr, and possible disciple of St. Peter. Apollinaris was born in Antioch, Turkey, and became the first bishop of Ravenna, in Italy. He suffered exile because of his preaching and converts. When Emperor Vespasian banished Christians, Apollinaris was beaten by a mob and reputedly died soon after from his wounds. His shrine in the Benedictine Abbey of Classe in Ravenna was once a popular pilgrimage destination. Apollinaris was credited with many miracles. He also appeared to St. Romuald, the founder of the Camaldolese. He is patron of Ravenna, Burthsccheid, Aachen, Remagen, and Düsseldorf, and he is invoked against gout, epilepsy, and diseases of the sexual organs. Apollinaris is depicted as a bishop in liturgical art. His cult was confined to local calendars in 1969.
