The Triumph of the Cross 14th September

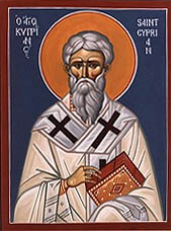


The True Cross was found by St Helena 14th Sept 320.

Our Lady of Sorrows 15th September The title "Our Lady of Sorrows" focuses on Mary's intense suffering during the passion and death of Christ. "The Seven Dolours," the title by which it was celebrated in the 17th century, referred to the seven swords that pierced the Heart of Mary.

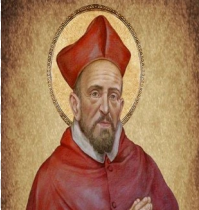
St. Cornelius 16th September

Became Pope in 251 and died in exile at Civitavecchia in 253.

Bishop of Carthage, teacher and preacher, martyr.



St. Robert Bellarmine 1542–1621 17th September

Jesuit, Cardinal Bishop of Capua, involved in theological controversies of the time. Patron of catechists
