The True Cross was found by St Helena 14th Sept 320. **Dur Lady of Sorrows 15th September** The title "Our Lady of Sorrows" focuses on Mary's intense suffering during the passion and death of Christ. "The Seven Dolors," the title by which it was celebrated in the 17th century, referred to the


seven swords that pierced the Heart of Mary.

St. Cornelius 16th September

St. Cyprian 210—258 16th September Bishop of Carthage, teacher and preacher, martyr.
