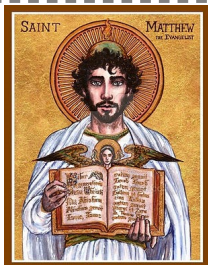

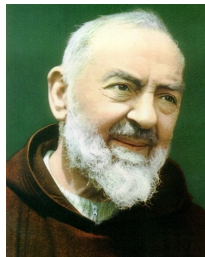


Saints of the Week

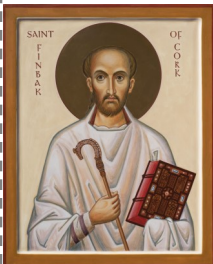
St. Matthew 21st Sept. The tax collector, may also be identified with Levi, son of Alphaeus in Mk. 2:13. He is said to have been a missionary in Persia and Ethiopia Patron of accountants, bookkeepers, tax-collectors, customs officers and security guards. At present we are using Matthew's Gospel in our Sunday Liturgy.

Padro Pio 23rd Sept.

Born in southern Italy in 1887 entered the Capuchin Order in 1903 and was ordained in 1910 after the WWI he received the Stigmata the word spread and pilgrims came to see the monk he founded a Hospital for the suffering 1947 and formed prayer groups in 1956. These still have wide appeal with over 400,000 members. He died in 1968 and was beatified in 1999 and Canonized in 2002.



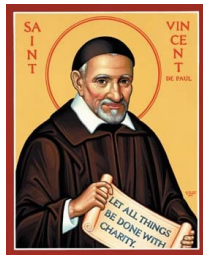
St Eunan 23rd Sept. Born in Donegal and was abbot of Iona. He patron of the Diocese of Raphoe the diocese covers most of Donegal.



St. Finbarr 25th Sept. Parton of the diocese of Cork.

Came to Loch Irce (Gougane Barra) and probably lived there as a hermit. When disciples gathered round him he moved to Cork at the mouth of the Lee where he founded a monastery that became a famous centre of learning. The Diocese covers all of cork city and areas around Bantry, Bandon and Kinsale

St. Vincent de Paul, priest 1580-1660 Monday 27th Sept. Founded the Congregation of the Mission (the Vincentians) and the Daughters of Charity (1633), the first sisters to work outside their convents in active service.



St. Wenceslaus, 28th Sept. 905-925, Prince of Bohemia, killed by his brother. Patron of brewers.

St. Lawrence Ruiz and his companions. 28th Sept. During the period 1633-1637 these sixteen martyrs, associates of the Order of Preachers, shed their blood out of love for Christ in the



city of Nagasaki, Japan.

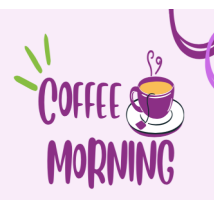
