St. Wenceslaus, 28th Sept. 905—925, Prince of Bohemia, killed by his brother.



St Jerome St. Jerome 340-420 30th Sept. Born in the mid-4th century in Stridon,

1st October Theresa of Lisieux Marie Francoise Therese Martin was born at Alencon on the 2nd January, 1873 and died at the Carmel in Lisieux on the 30th September 1897. She was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II in 1997. Patron of missions, florists, aviators and France.

2nd October Guardian Angels Catholic tradition has

recognised that not only individual people have guardian angels but also homes, cities and states.



3rd Columba Marmion Columba was born in Queen Street, Dublin, Ireland on 1 April 1858, into a large and very religious family; three of his sisters became nuns. His father, William Marmion was from Clane, County Kildare. His mother, Herminie Cordier, was French. Columba was one of the most popular and influential Catholic authors of the 20th century. His books are considered spiritual classics. In August 1909, Marmion was elected abbot 28 September 1909 Abbot Primate of

the Benedictine Order A cure from cancer obtained after a woman from St. Cloud, Minnesota, visited his tomb in 1966 was investigated by the Church and recognized as miraculous in 2000, leading to his beatification in that year

4th October St. Francis of Assisi 1181-1226, Abandoned all things for the love of Christ, founded the Friars Minor, and with St. Clare the Poor Clares. For the last two years of his life he suffered the stigmata. The patron saint of ecologists
