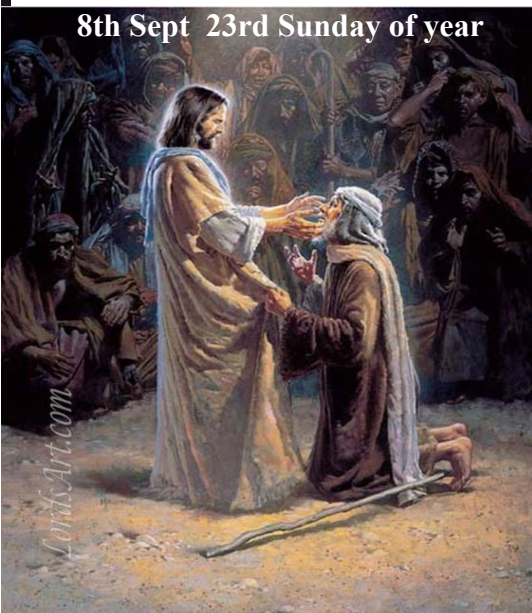

Saints of the week



St. Ciaran. 512–545 9th September
 Son of a travelling carpenter of Connaught, he studied under Finnian of Clonard, went as a monk to Enda on the Aran Islands where he was ordained priest. He finally settled at Clonmacnoise where he founded a monastery which became one of the most important centres of learning in Ireland.

St Peter Claver 9th September.
 Went to South America ordained in 1615 and preached to the Slaves and worked with. The slave trade thrived in South America despite condemnation for Pope Paul III and Pius IV. Peter died from a disease that he caught while doing his pastoral work. He was Canonized by Pope Leo XIII 1888.



St Ailbe Died 528AD 12th September
 Founded a monastery in Emily, went to Rome and was ordained a bishop and is the patron saint of the Diocese of Cashel and Emily. It covers east Limerick and Mid Tipperary.



St. John Chrysostom, 347-407 13th September
 One of the four great Greek Doctors, and "Golden-mouthed" preacher, was Archbishop of Constantinople. He incurred much opposition and died in exile. Patron saint of preachers

Please present your stamped booklet (with the 7 stamps included) no later than 5.30pm at Galway Cathedral where you will receive a certificate indicating that you completed The Galway Camino
