### Saints of the Week

**13<sup>th</sup> Edward the Confessor** Edward the Confessor was the son of King Ethelred III and his Norman wife, Emma. King Canute invaded England and took the throne. Edward remained in Normandy, was brought up a Norman, and in 1042, on the death of Canute he was acclaimed king of England. His reign was a peaceful one characterized by his good rule and remission of heavy taxes and he was good to his people. The struggle between Saxon and Norman was to be the predominant issue of Edwards reign. During the crises Edward became more interested in religious affairs and built St. Peter's Abbey at Westminster, the site of the present Abbey, where he is buried. His piety gained him the surname "the Confessor". He died in London on January 5, and he was canonized in 1161 by Pope Alexander III. **14<sup>th</sup> St Callistus** Became Pope in 217, opposed by Hippolytus. He died at the hands of a mob in 222.



### 15<sup>th</sup> October St. Teresa of Avila 1515–1582

Established the Carmelite convents under a reformed rule, and wrote much on prayer and the spiritual life. Patron of lace-makers, and headache sufferers.

### 16<sup>th</sup> October St. Gall

Was a monk of Bangor who set out with Columbanus for the Continent. When Columbanus was exiled from France, Gall accompanied him to Bregenz on Lake Constance. When Columbanus crossed into Italy, Gall remained in Switzerland. He lived in a hermitage, which later became the monastery of St. Gallen. He died around 630.



### St. Hedwig 1174–1243

Wife of the Duke of Silesia, mother of seven children, some of whom caused her trouble, devoted herself to charitable works.

### St. Margaret Mary, 1647-1690

Visionary and ascetic, revived devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus,

exemplary in her patience and trust

**17<sup>th</sup> October St Ignatius**, Bishop of Antioch, died a martyr at Rome c. 107

### 18<sup>th</sup> October St. Luke

He was with St. Paul on his second missionary journey and during his imprisonment in Rome. Represented in art by an ox. Patron of butchers, book-binders, doctors and surgeons, artists, glassworkers. Wrote a Gospel and the Act of the Apostles.
