

19th October St John De Brebeuf and Companions

They preached the word of God in Canada and the north-eastern United States. Their work was spreading the word among the Native American tribes. Seven missionaries were tortured and put to death. They are patrons of Canada.

Founded the Passionists in Rome. Noted for preaching on the Passion of Christ and tending the sick, the dying and the lapsed.




23rd October John of Capistrano 1386-1456

Studied civil and canon law and joined the Franciscan Order. In ! a battle at Belgrade he contracted fever and died there. Patron saint of jurists and military chaplains.


24th October St. Anthony Mary Claret 1807-1870
